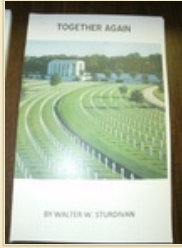

The three novels are *Osage*, *Together Again*, and *Bail Out Over Munster*.

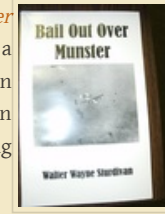


Osage is a western novel, taking place in New Mexico in the Old West.

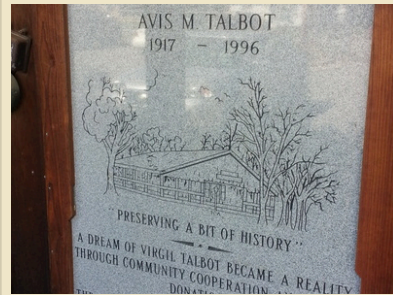
