HELP NEEDED! BECK PRAIRIE CEMETERY, COLCORD, DELAWARE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA!

Help at the Beck Prairie Cemetery has been requested by the current caretakers: Elmer Marshall, Jiggs Marshall, Elzie Cherry and Donley Harrington.

The cemetery is located Section 28, Twp 21, Range 25, two miles east of Colcord, just north of Highway 116. It is on private

Donley Harrington wishes to share the following notice:

"I have seen this cemetery grown up twice in the past. I believe that if this is allowed again, that within a few years, it will not be usable. Some of you need to step forward to organize and find a way for maintenance of this historic property.

A couple of suggestions would be,:

#1 to support professionals to do the annual mowing and

#2 organize an annual cleanup in the spring and fall.

The Beck Prairie Cemetery was established about 1839/1840 by Jeffrey Jr and Sally Downing Beck family. It consists of one acre. It is described on Robert Beck's allotment papers; he was a son of Jeff and Sally Beck. It is estimated there may be a minimum of 130 burials on the property. These burials include Civil War Veterans, and WWI and WWII veterans. Also, three men who died on the same day at the infamous Zeke Proctor Trial of April 15, 1872.

For your convenience, we offer this index online. Each Obituary/Death Notice is indexed by Last Name, Date of Death, and Date of Birth to make searching easy and accurate. The index may be accessed by the letter of the last name.

The staff at TL&M will be growing this index over the next several months to make even more obituary and death notice information available.

If you would like a copy of any indexed obituary/death notice, we make it easy by offering a printable form that can be filled out and mailed to our office. In return, the TL&M staff will provide photocopies --via postal mail--from the source(s) that we have indexed.


