We are very proud of our quilt collection. Some of the quilts we have include:

- A beautifully embroidered quilt commemorating the annual Talbot Reunion in New Florence, Missouri. It was donated to TL&M in 1990 by Amy Stonebraker of Riverdale, Georgia.
- An embroidered signature quilt made by Roxy Kirby in 1948 and donated by Pam Kirby Sitton.
- A gorgeous friendship quilt made by Sadie Beck Cherry as a gift to her daughter, Velva, in 1958. It was donated to TL&M by John and Velva Kinion in 1991.



Also included are quilts from the late 19th century and early 20th century.

So many of these types of quilts leave such a legacy and are great piece of American history.
